Cincinnati Police Department – Officer Dent

### Corryville Community Development Corporation – Brandon Williams

- Request for \$300k from City of Cincinnati through Neighborhood Business Development Improvement Program (NBDIP) for “white boxing” of approximately 6k square feet of Mecklenburg Gardens to get it up for inhabitation / rental.
  - This includes: 5 bathrooms (2 new ones); New Electrical Panel; plumbing; heating and cooling systems; ramps through patio for ADA accessibility; some demolition; new windows
  - Letter of Support being requested
  - Community Council members voted in support of the letter with 10 people voting for, 0 against, 0 abstaining
