Call to Order and Opening Comments

Police and Safety Report

Cincinnati Police Department – Officers Dent and Pettis

- Crime stats constant in Corryville.
- Theft from autos a bit higher than last year
- Fusus connect camera system - <https://connectcincinnati.org/> – register your residential doorbell cameras with the system to help with any crimes that happen in your area. Your camera will only be accessed with your permission. Footage can be used to find suspects and address crimes in the area.
- Question from the community about 3 rapes in the neighborhood. CPD will follow up to find out if these are between strangers or acquaintances
- Captain Pettis met with Short Vine Business Association this week regarding the street takeovers on Short Vine. They have seen groups of teens – too young to go into bars – on Short Vine. CPD arrested 30+ juveniles and took them to diversion locations. UCPD dispersed crowds alongside CPD.
- Short Vine has special early curfew for youth – 9pm, which is earlier than citywide curfew for them at 11pm.
- CPD is positioning units in parks and in attractive areas like Short Vine to preempt these large groups of underage children being in areas after curfew.

UCPD – Officer Sparks

- Orientation now for incoming freshman and their parents
- Athletic summer camps going on now
- Move-ins start August 15th and go until August 23rd.
- Fall semester classes start August 24th.

- Discussion of long-term care options in the home or in the nursing home and being able to have home care paid for just as nursing care home would be.
- Medicaid case managers will work with families to coordinate benefits and services
- A Medicaid trust (the best are irrevocable) can be used to protect assets if they need to get some health services. Without this trust in place, your retirements savings or retirement income will be used to pay for services before Medicaid kicks in.
- These trusts need to be set up at least five years before you need them because if not, the federal government will be able to access these dollars.

Cincinnati Metro

- Here to talk about the updates on the Bus Rapid Transit system
- Working on making system more multi-nodal – meaning not having to go downtown all the time to move from one bus to another.
